Dear Parent/Carer

The Governing body have read the enclosed report from Ofsted and understand that the conclusion, that the school requires improvement, may appear concerning but there are many positive elements.

The inspectors were clear that our children love coming to school. They observed that children feel safe; they behave well and enjoy a range of learning activities that strengthen their spiritual, moral, social and cultural development, which prepares them well for modern life. They also noted that the pupils are well supported and nurtured and parents have told them that they are happy with the school.

The inspectors recognised that many improvements are already underway, particularly with regard to teaching and standards in mathematics and attendance. However, the inspectors have also identified other areas where the school needs to improve.

The headteacher and her colleagues, with support from the school governors and the local authority, are identifying the changes required to achieve the aim of developing every child. The governing body fully support the school in its ambition and will do whatever they can do, to help the school reach the expected outcomes.

It is important that we all play our part and so I am asking you to help out. Please keep making sure that your child arrives on time for school, every day, ready to learn. Please keep them in school and save holidays for the holidays. Help them with their learning and always remember that if you want to know what else you can do or have any questions, you can arrange to speak to your child's teacher or a member of the senior team.
