Health & Safety Updates

It's great to see so many pupils in the playground at 8.45 am ready for learning. Please remember they are your responsibility until the bell goes. There has been recent news reports of grapes causing breathing difficulties for your children. As a result the catering company are no longer sending grapes at lunchtime. Please do not send grapes in for your child for fruit time either. If grapes are eaten at home the advice is to cut them in half first.

REMINDER term time holidays are **not authorised** and should you choose to take your child away during term time or return late back to school after a school holiday you may be liable to incur a **Penalty Notice** issued by the Local Authority which could cost you **£120 per child per parent**
