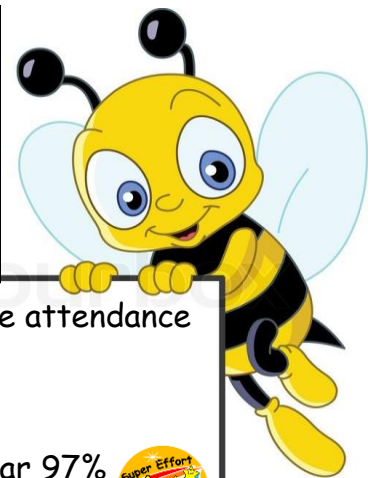
## Library Books and Home Readers
