Mathematics:

- Counting & writing numerals to 100.
- Can identify one more and less than a given number.
- Number bonds secured to 20 and related to Identify the properties of 2D shapes.
- Different denominations of coins.
- Tell the time to the hour. (o'clock)



Science: Ourselves and Seasonal changes:

Seasonal changes is an on going focus across the year.

- Compare and identify the parts of the body
- Looking at the 5 senses and identifying the parts of the human body they're associated.
- Name the four seasons and the changes that's occur to the climate during these.
- Working scientifically using a range of techniques.

- Identifying and comparing a range of different types of homes.
- Looking at the features of the local area
- Naming the countries and capital cities that form the United Kingdom.



Religious education: Harvest festival and Christmas.

- Talking about the Harvest festival and the historical significance.

- Performing a nativity as classes.



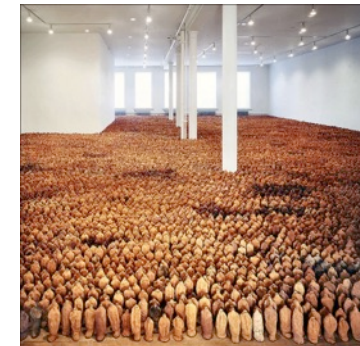
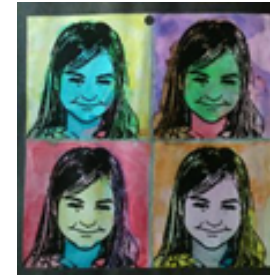
Design Technology: Cookery
