I hope you are all well. Thank you for all your support with helping your children learn at home.

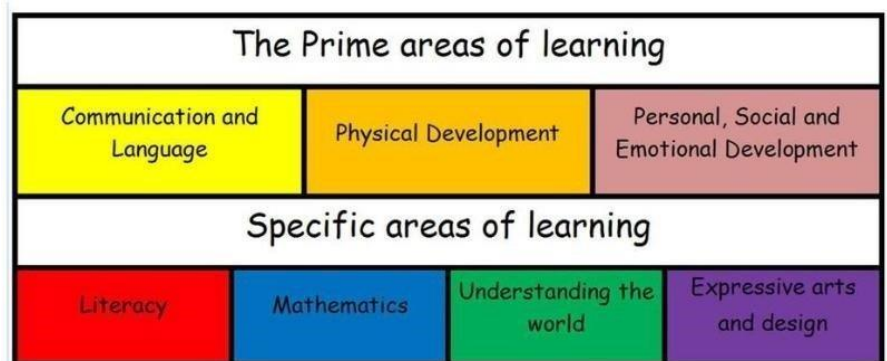
After the Easter break we will be organising **core tasks** that children can complete on a weekly basis at home. These tasks will be linked to the Summer Term curriculum. Where possible we will provide links to videos/resources or photos that you can use to help complete the tasks.

A core task overview for Reception will be posted in the 'Home Learning' section of the school website during the Easter break. Following this, each week we will post a document which will include a task for each area of learning. For Nursery, we will post a selection of practical activities you can enjoy with your child. You will receive weekly text messages to inform you when core tasks have been uploaded on the school website.

Once your child has completed their tasks, if possible, you can take a photograph and e-mail it to your child's class teacher. Class teachers will be available to respond to any queries or give feedback from 9am to 1pm daily from Monday to Friday. The class e-mail addresses are attached to this letter.

The Early Years curriculum is broken down into 7 'areas of learning'.

There is more information about this on the school website. Hover over the **learning** tab and then click on '**Early Years – Nursery + Reception**'. You will find the information under the heading '**Information for Parents**'.



It is important you read with your children daily; you read to them and they read to you.

Reception children **must** continue to practise their phonics every day. I have posted a video on our Instagram account with the phonemes (sounds). It would be useful for Nursery children to listen to this video so they become familiar with the sounds.
