## Important: Home Learning Update

Dear Parents/Carers,

I hope you are all well. Thank you for all your support with helping your children learn at home.

After the Easter break we will be organising **core tasks** that children can complete on a weekly basis at home. These tasks will be linked to the Summer Term curriculum. Where possible we will provide links of videos/resources that pupils can use on-line to help them complete the tasks.

A core task coverage overview for year 1 and 2 will be posted on the 'Home Learning' section of the school website during the Easter break.

Following this each week we will post a document which will include at least 2 core tasks for maths, English and the Foundation Subjects. Each week will have an overview of expectations, and worksheets and resources the children may need. Where appropriate core tasks will be differentiated using a code.

You will receive weekly text messages to inform you when core tasks have been uploaded on the school website.

Once your child has completed their tasks, if possible, you can take a photograph and e-mail it to your child's class teacher. If you do not have a printer then tasks can be completed on blank paper.

Class teachers will be available to respond to any queries or give feedback from 9am to 1pm daily from Monday to Friday.

Please continue to encourage your child to read every day and do some form of physical exercise.

Year 1 pupils **must** continue to practise their phonics every day. Phonics play is now free to use.

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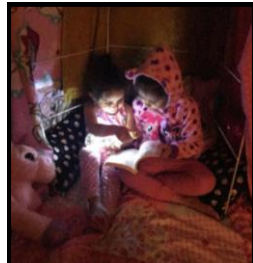
