Hello from Sian






Wellbeing Wednesday

On Wellbeing Wednesday, Arun used a variety of materials to make this impressive guitar.



- Step 1: Get your bread.

- Step 4: Add the tuna.
- Step 5: Add the other ingredients.
- Step 6: Cut the sandwich into halves.
- Step 7: Enjoy your sandwich.







Kerem published his exciting newspaper report on Mr Grinling's stolen lunch, filled with emotive adverbs and dramatic quotes.
