Attendance Information

I have had several discussions with parents this week about their children's attendance. If your child needs to leave school during school time for an appointment we need to see an appointment card, a text or a hospital letter.

We have to explain our attendance levels to the Education Welfare Officer from the Local Authority. This data is then shared with the Department of Education.

We had a cake sale to raise money for the disaster in Turkey and Syria. We raised £233.61. Thank you for your generosity.





We have received two very generous donations from a parent and a neighbour. We are extremely grateful for their kindness. This money will help us to buy resources to support our children's learning.


